ifs=$IFS
IFS='\'

PDFARGUMENTS=""
fpaths=`echo "$NAUTILUS_SCRIPT_SELECTED_FILE_PATHS" | sort`
for file in $fpaths
do
    if [ -f "$file" ]; then
        base=${file%.*}
        ext=${file##*.}
        if [ "$ext" == "pdf" ]; then
            PDFARGUMENTS="$PDFARGUMENTS \"$file\""
            pdfdir=`dirname "$file"`
        fi
    fi
done

szSavePath=$(zenity --file-selection --save --confirm-overwrite);echo
"$szSavePath"

if [ -n "$PDFARGUMENTS" ]; then
    eval pdftk "$PDFARGUMENTS" cat output "\"$szSavePath\""
fi
IFS=$ifs
```
